HAVING REGARD TO the University Regulations governing university Master's degrees and Advanced Training Courses, professional refresher courses and preparation for state examinations for qualification to practice the professions and for public competitions, as last amended by Rectoral Decree no. 4 of 3 May 2013

HAVING REGARD TO art. 15 of Law no. 183 of 12 November 2011, "Rules on certificates and declarations in lieu of certificates

HAVING REGARD TO D.P.R. no. 445 of 28 December 2000, entitled "Testo unico delle disposizioni legislative e regolamentari in materia di documentazione amministrativa";

HAVING REGARD TO article 32 of Law no. 69 of 18 June 2009, "Elimination of waste related to the maintenance of documents in paper form";

HAVING REGARD to the resolutions of 12/06/2018 and 29/06/2018 with which, respectively, the Academic Senate and the Board of Directors approved the establishment and activation, for the A.Y. 2018/2019, of the University Master's degree;

HAVING REGARD TO the resolution of the Departmental Council of 20 September 2021 which approved the activation of the aforementioned Master's degree for the academic year 2021/2022;

HAVING REGARD TO the resolutions of the Academic Senate of 16 November 2021 and of the Board of Directors of 26 November 2021, which approved the request for renewal of the Master's degree in question;

CONSIDERED the request of 2 March 2021 made by Prof. Maria Paola Costi, Director of the Master's course, aimed at

1) Inclusion among the requirements for admission to the Master's course of specialist/master's degrees in: Biology classes 6/S and LM-6, Biomedical Engineering classes 26/S and LM-21, Science Technology of Industrial Chemistry classes 81/S and LM 71);

2) the extension of the deadline to 19 April 2022 for the submission of applications for admission to the 2nd level University Master's degree in: "Development, Manufacturing and Authorization of Biopharmaceuticals", in order to give a large number of candidates the opportunity to apply". HAVING REGARD TO the resolutions of the Academic Senate of 8 March 2022 and of the Board of Directors of 18 March 2022, with which the above-mentioned requests of the Director of the Master's degree course were accepted and consequently the amended project note;
