HAVING REGARD TO the Regulations for Master's and Advanced Training Courses;

HAVING REGARD TO the provision of the Rector of the University of Modena and Reggio Emilia Prot. n. 0328979 of 18/12/2025 - Rep. N 1387/2025, which announced the selection procedure for admission to the Postgraduate Course in "*Sound Engineering*" a.y. 2025/2026 (Available places: min. n. 18 max. n. 40) and the extension decree Prot. n. 0085041 of 16/03/2026 - Rep. N 287/2026;

HAVING REGARD TO the minutes concerning the proceedings of the Selection Committee for the admission to the aforementioned Postgraduate Course

HEREBY DECREES

Art. 1

The final list of candidates who applied for admission to the Postgraduate Course in "*Sound Engineering*" for the 2025–2026 academic year has been approved.

A total of 34 candidates have been accepted.

Art. 2

Candidates admitted to the Postgraduate Course in "*Sound Engineering*" for the 2025–2026 academic year are required to complete their enrollment exclusively through the online procedure described in the Call for Applications.

Art. 3

Appeals against this provision may be lodged:

- through a judicial appeal before the competent Regional Administrative Court within 60 days of full knowledge of this act, pursuant to art. 29 of Legislative Decree n. 104/2010;
- alternatively, through an extraordinary appeal within 120 days of the same date, pursuant to Presidential Decree n. 1199/1971.

Pursuant to art. 6, paragraph 4, of Decree-Law n. 19/2026, the decision on the extraordinary appeal is adopted by decree of the President of the Council of State, in accordance with the opinion of the Council of State, in place of the previous Decree of the President of the Republic, without prejudice to the regulations in force.
