CONSIDERING the Interministerial Decree of 11 November 2011, published in the Official Gazette no. 44 of 22/02/2012, regarding the equivalence of the diplomas obtained from the three-year Schools for Special Purposes established under Presidential Decree 162/1982 and the three-year University Diplomas established under Law 341/1990, to the degrees of the classes D.M. 509/1999 and D.M. 270/2004, for the purpose of participation in public competitions and subsequent modifications;

HAVING REGARD TO the Didactic Regulations of the University;

HAVING REGARD TO the University's regulations governing post-graduate professional master's programmes, professional courses, and preparation for state exams for the licensing of professions and public competitions, issued by Rector's Decree Repertory no. 856/2025 of 08/08/2025;

HAVING REGARD TO Law No. 33 of April 12, 2022 and its implementing decrees, which starting from the academic year 2022/2023 allow the simultaneous enrollment of students in two study programs, even at multiple universities and institutions of higher artistic, musical, and choreographic education (AFAM), both Italian and foreign;

HAVING REGARD TO the provisions of MIUR protocol n. 602 of 18 May 2011, concerning the enrolment of foreign and EU students in Italian state and non-state universities authorized to issue qualifications with legal value;

HAVING REGARD TO art. 15 of Law no. 183 of 12 November 2011, "Norme in materia di certificati e dichiarazioni sostitutive";

HAVING REGARD TO Presidential Decree no. 445 of 28 December 2000, recante il "Testo unico delle disposizioni legislative e regolamentari in materia di documentazione amministrativa";

ARTICLE 1 - Establishment

By D.M. 270 of 22/10/2004, the University of Modena and Reggio Emilia activates for the Academic Year 2026/2027, the Post-Degree II-level University Master's Programme in "*Development, Manufacturing, and Authorization of Biopharmaceuticals*".

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

The Post-Degree Master's Programme is aimed at holders of Master's degrees, such as: Pharmacy and Industrial Pharmacy (14/S or LM13); Medical, Veterinary and Pharmaceutical Biotechnology (9/S or LM9); Industrial Biotechnology (8/S or LM8); Chemical Engineering (27/S or LM22), Chemical Sciences (62/S or LM54), Biology (6/S or LM-6), Biomedical Engineering (26/S or LM-21), Industrial Chemistry Sciences and Technologies (81/S – LM 71).

It is also aimed at graduates of pre-Ministerial Decree 509/99 degree programmes in: Chemistry and Pharmaceutical Technologies or Chemistry and Pharmaceutical Technology, Pharmacy, Agro-Industrial Biotechnology, Biotechnology (Pharmaceutical Biotechnology specialisation), Biotechnology (Industrial Biotechnology specialisation), Biotechnology (Medical Biotechnology specialisation), Biotechnology (Veterinary Biotechnology specialisation), Chemical Engineering and Chemistry, Biological Sciences, Biomedical Engineering, Industrial Chemistry.

¹ This amount includes the annual per capita premium, to be paid by students, for the "Accident insurance" policy and the "Third-party liability insurance" policy, extended to the so-called medical malpractice, i.e., the liability arising from the exercise of medical activity (where provided).

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AUDITORS

It is possible to participate in the Master's Programme as an auditor.

Those interested may apply as auditors directly to the Master's organizational office (email: master_altaformazione@unimore.it) by submitting the pre-enrolment form (Annex C to this document) by the deadline. Once the activation of the Master's Programme has been confirmed, applicants will receive a request to complete their enrolment, along with instructions for the simultaneous payment of the enrolment fee.

Auditors do not obtain the title of Second-Level University Master's Programme and do not earn CFU credits. At the end of the course, they receive a certificate of attendance.

Deadline for submission of applications: June 30th, 2026 at 1:00 p.m.

Our 2nd Level Master's Programme aims to prepare specialized personnel with a high level of qualification, able to cover various professional positions within the biopharmaceutical drugs world.

These professionals will be qualified as:

- ◆ **Manager/Director of laboratories** with biotechnological and pharmacological characterization.
- ◆ **Coordinator of development and monitoring programs** of applied biotechnologies in human health, regarding the industrial development of biopharmaceutical products, the industrial aspects of biotechnological drugs production, and the management of scientific and process-related data with artificial Intelligence (AI).
- ◆ **Expert in management of the regulatory aspects** of the market authorizations, of the ethical and legal implications for the marketing of biopharmaceuticals with aspects of environmental protection and sustainability.



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Learning objectives:

Duration and location:

Course Location: Lessons are held remotely.

In-person classes are voluntary (2-3 visits to Modena) and will take place at the Department of Life Sciences, Via Campi 103, Modena.

Lessons will also be available via streaming through the master's online platform.

Course period: September 2026 - August 2027

Language: All lessons, lectures, and communications will be held entirely in English.

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Total hours:

The Master's Programme is structured in 1500 hours, for a total of 60 CFU:

- ◆ 240 hours of lectures;
- ◆ 375 hours of internship;
- ◆ 125 hours for the final test;

The remaining hours in individual study.

Teaching staff:

The Master's Programme teaching staff consists of experienced professionals and experts in the topics covered.

Admission procedure:

Evaluation of Qualifications: *Curriculum Vitae et Studiorum* and professional experience (50% of the score). Motivational Interview: (50% of the score)

ARTICLE 2 - Admission requirements

The selection process is open to anyone with a qualification obtained in Italy, as specified in Art. 1 of the call, or a similar academic qualification from a foreign university, with no age or nationality restrictions for participation.

For candidates holding a foreign academic degree, please refer to the procedure in Art. 3 "Applications for admission". For further information, please visit the website www.miur.it – Universities – Students – Foreign students. Non-EU citizens requiring a visa are reminded of the obligation to submit a pre-enrolment application on <https://www.universitaly.it>. Please note, as an EU or non-EU citizen residing in Italy, you do not need to apply on the Universitaly website.

The information provided by the candidates will be subject to thorough checks by the relevant departments to verify its truthfulness.

Candidates are admitted to the selection process with reserve of verification of the aforementioned requirements.



ARTICLE 3 - Applications for admission

Applications for admission to the selection procedure and any other supporting documents (qualifications and documents considered useful for the selection procedure) must be submitted to this Administration, under penalty of exclusion, by the peremptory deadline specified in Article 1, exclusively using the following computerised procedure:

- ♦ **via Internet:** register on the website www.esse3.unimore.it, a page which can also be accessed by following the path <http://www.unimore.it> – Services – IT Services – the ESSE3 desk, and subsequently log in with the credentials received following registration or with your own SPID credentials (Sistema Pubblico di Identità Digitale). Once you have logged in, in the Student Area, follow “Admission” – “Enrolment” – “Master”.

All helpful titles and documents must be attached electronically as PDF or RTF files with a maximum size of 20 MB. Attachments over 20MB should be split. For the application for admission, a non-refundable fee of € 25.00 must be paid.

Once the application for admission is completed, access www.esse3.unimore.it: after logging in, navigate to the “Tasse” section to view the fees you need to pay, exclusively through the pagoPA circuit. Payment methods are available on the University website at the following address: <https://www.unimore.it/it/didattica/immatricolazioni-e-iscrizioni/pagamenti>.

The payment of € 25.00 must be made by the peremptory deadline of the expiry date indicated in Art. 1.

It is important to note that the date of payment indicated on the telematic payment receipt (RT) is the valid date for the University. **Payments whose date on the payment receipt (RT) is after the established deadline will not be considered valid for the purpose of being included in the ranking list.** *Attention! Following “AgID” Agenzia per l’Italia digitale guidelines, the payment operation could be performed by the “PSP” (Payment Service Provider) the day after the request made by the payer, precluding admission.*

The submission of an admission application will only be considered complete once the data (“Save”) are saved after the candidate has given their explicit confirmation of the validity of the application at the end of the computer procedure mentioned above (consult the “Guide to the Application for Admission” published on the University website at the page <http://www.unimore.it/didattica/master.html>).

Anytime before saving and confirming the validity of data (“Salva i dati”), and before the call for application’s deadline, applicants can add, modify, or delete the titles and documents by connecting to the above-mentioned webpage (in this case, it is recommended to consult the “Guide to the Application for Admission”).

Applications and/or the relative annexes cannot be submitted by email or fax.

Applications for admission, submitted according to the above-mentioned procedures, are considered valid only if received by this Administration within the peremptory deadline of the call. Therefore, applications submitted after the deadline, or in a manner that does not follow the specifications outlined in this notice, will not be considered.



As part of the computerized application process, the candidate will need to provide the following information under their responsibility:

- ◆ First and last name;
- ◆ Place and date of birth;
- ◆ Residence, phone/mobile number, elected domicile for the purpose of any selection process and email address;
- ◆ Fiscal code (for those already in possession of it; those not in possession of the fiscal code must only confirm the one calculated automatically by the system);
- ◆ Citizenship;
- ◆ Possession of the academic qualification required for access (Art. 1 “Access Requirements” of the call) or equivalent qualification obtained from foreign universities;
- ◆ The exact name of the Master’s Programme they intend to participate in;
- ◆ Curriculum Vitae et Studiorum;
- ◆ Titles and any other relevant documents;
- ◆ In the case of candidates with disabilities, pursuant to Law no. 104 of 5 February 1992, the type of aid required to sit the exams.

By applying for admission, the candidate simultaneously agrees to promptly notify the university of any change of residence or address.

Applicants who fail to meet the eligibility requirements may be excluded from consideration at any time, ex officio. Applications that are submitted or received after the deadline, or in a manner that does not follow the specifications outlined in this notice, will not be considered.

The Administration cannot be held responsible for any loss of communication resulting from incorrect information, failure to provide or late notification of a change of address, technical problems or events caused by third parties, unforeseeable circumstances, or force majeure. Furthermore, the Administration cannot be held responsible for any non-receipt of documents due to actions or errors by third parties, as well as in case of mistakes made by the applicant when inserting attachments, or any instance of network downtime.

TITLES AND DOCUMENTS:

Candidates must attach various documents to the application form via the electronic system, depending on whether the declared academic qualification is Italian or foreign.

Candidates with an Italian qualification

Mandatory documentation, under penalty of exclusion:

- ◆ “Annex A”: self-certification of possession of the access requirement pursuant to articles 46 and 47 of D.P.R. 445/2000, using the facsimile provided at the end of the call for applications;
- ◆ curriculum vitae;
- ◆ copy of a valid ID Card;



Optional documentation:

- ◆ Titles and documents considered useful for assessment and a list thereof.
- ◆ Copy of a residence permit or receipt of the renewal request (for non-EU foreign students already residing in Italy)

Candidates with a foreign qualification

Mandatory documentation, under penalty of exclusion:

- ◆ The degree certificate with a list of exams passed, including an Italian translation (or using the facsimile “Annex B”);
- ◆ Curriculum Vitae et Studiorum;
- ◆ Copy of a valid ID card or passport.

Optional documentation:

- ◆ Titles and documents considered useful for assessment and a list thereof;
- ◆ Copy of a residence permit (only for non-EU residents).

Candidates with a foreign academic qualification are admitted to the selection process with reserve of verification of the aforementioned requirements. **In any case**, enrolment will be finalized only upon presentation, by the enrolment deadline, of all the necessary **original documentation** to the “*Ufficio Master e Alta Formazione*”, located in Via Università 4 – Modena (**as listed in the relevant section of Art. 5**). It is recommended to arrange for the collection of all necessary documentation well in advance.

Pursuant to Art. 15 of Law no. 183 of 12 November 2011, certificates issued by the public administration regarding status, personal qualities, and facts are valid and usable only in relations between private individuals. In relations with public administration bodies and managers of public services, certificates and affidavits are always replaced by the declarations referred to in Articles 46 and 47.

The information provided by the candidates will be subject to thorough checks by the relevant departments to verify its truthfulness.

ARTICLE 4 - Admission procedures and publication of the ranking list

The selection process is described in Article 1. Once the selection procedure is complete, the selection committee will create the final merit ranking list. Candidates will be admitted to the Master's Programme, by decree of the Rector, once the regularity of the documents has been verified, according to the ranking order and up to the number of available spots in the program.,

This decree will be published on the University's online notice board at the following link <https://wss.unimore.it/public/albo/> and on the University website in the dedicated section at the link <https://www.unimore.it/it/ateneo/bandi>, where the opening and closing period for enrolment for the winners of the selection procedure will also be indicated.

These publications will constitute official notification to the interested parties for all legal purposes. NO INFORMATION WILL BE GIVEN OVER THE PHONE.



ARTICLE 5 - Registration of those admitted

During the enrolment procedure, the system mandatorily requires the following documents:

- ◆ **a digital front/back copy of your identity document** (Identity Card or Passport);
- ◆ **a passport-size photo** (*please note: it will not be possible to adapt the image to the page, therefore the color photo must be attached in the correct format and orientation, dimensions 3.5 x 4.0 cm, and it must show a front-facing close-up of the face on a neutral background*).

Under penalty of forfeiture, **within the peremptory deadline of twelve natural and consecutive days**, starting from the day after enrolment opens, candidates who are successfully placed in the final merit ranking must enrol in the Master exclusively through the following online procedure:

- ◆ **via Internet:** connect to the University website at the page www.esse3.unimore.it/ and “Login” using the username and password assigned by the system during registration for the admission test, or those already held by students of the University of Modena and Reggio Emilia, or via SPID; then follow the path in the Student Area: “Enrolment” – “Enrolment in programmed access courses”. You can consult the “Online Enrolment Guide” available at the link: <https://www.unimore.it/it/servizi/guide-alle-procedure-line>.

Candidates who have been successfully placed in the final merit ranking list must confirm the data already entered at the time of the application for admission and finalize the enrolment procedure to generate the enrolment application in PDF format. It is not necessary to send the PDF generated at the end of the procedure.

After completing the enrolment application, access www.esse3.unimore.it: after logging in, go to the “Tasse” section to view the amounts due for the payment of the required contributions. Payment must be made, under penalty of exclusion, by the peremptory deadline mentioned above. Payment methods are indicated on the University website at the following address: <https://www.unimore.it/it/didattica/immatricolazioni-e-iscrizioni/pagamenti>.

IMPORTANT: for the University, the date of PAYMENT indicated on the telematic payment receipt (RT) is the valid date. Attention: The payment operation could be performed on the day following the request made by the payer, precluding enrolment.

The payment of the instalment must be made within the deadline set in Art. 1 - “Registration fee” of this call, exclusively following the same procedures as above.

Closing the enrolment application on Esse3 without paying the required contributions and fees does not complete the enrolment in the Master's Programme. It is not necessary to send the PDF generated at the end of the procedure.



For EU and non-EU citizens residing in Italy with a foreign academic qualification

By the final enrolment deadline, the following **original documentation** must be submitted to the Ufficio Master e Alta formazione, located at Via Università 4 – Modena:

1. Original (or certified copy) of the **Degree Certificate**, translated and with confirmation of authenticity. The authenticity of foreign degrees and certificates must be confirmed in one of the following ways:
 - ♦ **Legalisation or Apostille**: qualifications and certificates must be legalised in order to guarantee their authenticity, at the Italian Embassy; check here the procedures established by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation - MAECI for translation and legalisation (<https://www.esteri.it/it/servizi-consolari-e-visti/italiani-all-estero/traduzione-e-legalizzazione-documenti/>). If the country where the qualification was obtained adheres to the Hague Convention (1961), instead of legalisation one must have **the Apostille** affixed to the documents by the designated internal authority. See list on (<https://www.hcch.net/en/instruments/conventions/authorities1/?cid=41>). Thanks to specific agreements, it is not necessary to legalise or apostille documents for the following countries: Belgium, Denmark, France, Ireland, Latvia, Estonia, Germany, Austria.
 - ♦ **certificate of authenticity verification** issued by CIMEA - Italian ENICNARIC center, to be requested from CIMEA via registration at <https://cimea.diplo-me.eu>. More information can be found on <https://www.cimea.it/pagina-attestat-di-comparabilita-e-verifica-dei-titoli>;
2. Documentation on the value of the title such as:
 - ♦ **Declaration Of Value** of the degree certificate, issued by the Italian Embassy/Consulate in the country where the qualification was obtained, or in the country where the issuing school is located;
 - or*
 - ♦ **Diploma Supplement** drawn up according to the European Commission's model, for academic qualifications awarded by countries belonging to the European Higher Education Area (Bologna Process), signed and legalized;
 - or*
 - ♦ Documentation related to the degree certificate issued by CIMEA – www.cimea.it, specifically:
 - **Certificate Of Correspondence** downloadable directly from the “Ardi” platform at <https://ardi.cimea.it/it> (for countries that are signatories of the Lisbon Convention), if the country where the qualification was obtained is not listed, a **Certificate Of Comparability**, to be requested from CIMEA via registration at <https://cimea.diplo-me.eu>.
 - Attention: CIMEA will not issue a Certificate of Comparability if a Certificate of Correspondence is available.
3. Certificate with the list of exams taken during the study program (transcript of records) or Diploma Supplement (if adopted);
4. Residence permit or receipt, issued by the post office in Italy, proving the submission of a residence permit renewal request (for non-EU students residing in Italy);



5. Identity Document or Passport;
6. Passport-sized photo.

Certificates issued by the relevant authorities of the country of citizenship must comply with the regulations in force in that country and must also be translated. Documents in foreign languages must be accompanied by a certified Italian translation, made by the relevant Italian diplomatic or consular representative or by an official translator.

The Office, after verifying the correctness and completeness of the documentation submitted by the student, will make the required contributions for enrollment available in Esse3 under the "Taxes" section, to be paid through the pagoPA circuit, and finalize the enrollment once payment is received.

Foreign students who do not yet have a tax code must request it from the Agenzia delle Entrate (once in Italy) and submit a copy of the tax code card issued by the Agenzia, within 30 days from the start of the Master's Programme, to the Ufficio Master e Alta formazione, exclusively via email to master_altaformazione@unimore.it.

Those who fail to regularize their enrollment within the terms and procedures outlined above will be considered as having forfeited their place. Candidates who have provided false declarations will be disqualified. Vacant places will be assigned to other candidates according to the order of the final merit ranking (Article 6).

If the minimum number of enrolled students is not reached, the course activation will be revoked, and any enrollment fees paid will be refunded.

In the event of enrollment and subsequent withdrawal from the Master's Programme, the candidate must notify the Rector by e-mail, copying the Director of the Master. If the withdrawal occurs at a time when the ranking of eligible candidates can still be used to fill the vacant place, the University reserves the right to refund the fees paid at the time of enrollment. If the withdrawal occurs at a later time, the fees will not be refunded.

ARTICLE 6 – Substitution

In case of vacant places, those entitled to a spot will be required, via email, to enroll under penalty of forfeiture, following the procedures outlined in the previous article, **within a strict deadline of four consecutive calendar days**, starting from the day after the email is sent.

The University of Modena and Reggio Emilia disclaims any responsibility in the case of incorrect addresses provided by the candidate or failure to promptly notify any address changes via email to master_altaformazione@unimore.it.

ARTICLE 7 – Attendance Requirements

Attendance at classes is mandatory, and the minimum requirements for the issuance of the certificate are:

- ◆ Attendance for at least 75% of the total duration of the theoretical classes;



- ◆ Passing the intermediate verification tests;
- ◆ Passing the final exam.

ARTICLE 8 - Academic Credits and Degree Awarded
