Cat. D: the rates **apply** to students in the “STUDENTS WITHIN THE STANDARD PROGRAMME DURATION” category who are not subject to merit-based requirements (with a minimum fee of EUR 500.00); **FM 5, FM 6.**

Cat. E(+50%): the rates **apply** to students in the “STUDENTS BEYOND THE STANDARD PROGRAMME DURATION” category without a merit requirement (with a minimum fee of EUR 700.00) and to those enrolled in postgraduate schools, for whom the minimum fee of EUR 700.00 applies; **FM 7.**
